All FamilySearch Memories are stored in the Granite Mountain Records Vault

GALLERY- Contains YOUR memory contributions to FamilySearch.

A MEMORY is:

- A Photographic image file (jpg, tif, bmp, png)
- A Document (pdf or image file)
- An Audio file (mp3 or m4a)
- A Story (Created using the FamilySearch “Create a Story” Feature)

Each Contributed MEMORY NEEDS:

- A Tag-Allows you to ATTACH!
- To be ATTACHED! (If you die and your photos are unattached it is as if they never existed)
- A Title
- Optional-Description
- METADATA-Add it in the Property Details of your image and audio files before you upload them!

Albums-Dropbox for Memories of the Living

- Allow you to Group Photos while still keeping them in your Gallery
- Have a share feature that creates a link to the album through email, the recipient need not log-in to FamilySearch to view the memories in that Album whether the subjects are living or dead

Fun Stuff

- Social- Each Memory can be chosen as a FAVORITE, LIKED, PINNED, TWEETED, and G+1
- A COMMENT can be added to each Memory (Please thank people in comments or via messaging!)
- Under a Memory EVENT, if you put in a Place, it GEOLOCATES to the satellite view of that location!
- Memories App for adding Photos or Audio from your phone (Don't recommend the Story Feature)
- MEMORIES “FIND” -Look up anything! Recipes are great!

Hint

- If you name your files adequately BEFORE you upload them, you can go into the Memory DETAILS and just copy and paste the Title, no typing!

Memories People

- Is a full Gallery for those who haven't contributed or favorited any Memories
- Allows you to filter in fun and useful ways
